## WHAT IS WOOD BADGE?

Wood Badge for the 21<sup>st</sup> Century is the ultimate leadership and team building course developed by the Boy Scouts of America. The course draws upon the most current leadership models used by corporate America, academic circles, and other successful outdoor leadership organizations. The course is built upon the time-tested training concepts of Robert Baden-Powell, Scouting's founder. It has been newly recast to meet the needs of 21<sup>st</sup> Century Scout leaders.

## ATTENDEE PRE-REQUISITES

1. You must be registered with the BSA (youth older than 18 may also attend)
2. You must have completed "This is Scouting" (all leaders), Position Specific training (all leaders), and Introduction to Outdoor Leadership Skills (Boy Scout leaders), or BALOO or OWL (Cub Scout leaders).
3. You must complete the Annual Health and Medical Record form (available at [www.scouting.org](http://www.scouting.org))

## COST

The course fee is **\$235.00**. This fee includes the cost of all meals during the two weekends, training materials, and one custom course baseball cap.

## COURSE SIZE

The course will be limited to a maximum of 48 participants. A stand-by list will be created if needed.

## WOOD BADGE PHASES

Wood badge training consists of two phases: Phase 1 – the practical phase and Phase 2 – the application phase.

Phase 1 consists of two 3-day weekend camping experiences plus a minimum of one Patrol meeting occurring between the two weekends.

Phase 2 is an 18 month period after the completion of Phase 1 during which you will complete the tasks set forth in the "Wood Badge Ticket" that you develop for yourself as part of the practical phase.

## WOOD BADGE TICKET

Your Wood Badge Ticket is your written commitment to complete a set of goals you define related to your current Scouting position. The objective of the Wood Badge Ticket is to provide you with the opportunity to practice the leadership skills presented during the course and to provide you the opportunity to significantly strengthen your unit or Scouting program.

## RECOGNITION

Upon satisfactory completion of your Wood Badge Ticket, as certified by a Ticket Counselor and yourself, you will be presented with the Wood Badge Neckerchief, Woggle, Beads, and Certificate at an appropriate ceremony.
